

3 Open Student Research Assistant (HiWi) Positions with Field Work in Pollinator Research!

Description

The Chair of Nature Conservation and Landscape Ecology at the University of Freiburg is looking for 3 student assistants to support field data collection for the WildPosh project (www.wildposh.eu). WildPosh is a pan-European project with the overall aim to improve the assessment of the risk of pesticide exposure to wild pollinators as well as the health of pollinators and pollination services in Europe. As part of the project, we will sample different matrices in the wild, including pollen, nectar, water and soil, and conduct pollinator, floral and farmer surveys to determine the exposure pathways of pesticides from crop fields.

Position

3 student assistants with an education background in the environmental sciences, biology or a related field of study. The pay grade is determinant on the student's educational level.

Duration

April 2025 to June 2025 (3 months). Most of the field work will be carried out in the month of May.

Requirements:

- Ability to participate in fieldwork in various locations in Baden-Württemberg.
- Good knowledge of German **and** English.
- Driving license
- Motivation, reliability, willingness to learn and communicate in a team.
- Flexibility (the work is concentrated in specific weeks and requires availability especially during 1 or 2 weeks in May; more details will be given in person to interested candidates)
