

Open Student Research Assistant (HiWi) Positions – We are Hiring!

Description

The Chair of Nature Conservation and Landscape Ecology at the University of Freiburg is looking for up to 3 student assistants to support the semi-field study for the WildPosh project. WildPosh is a pan-European project with the overall aim to improve the assessment of the risk of pesticide exposure to wild pollinators as well as the health of pollinators and pollination services in Europe. As part of the project, we will carry out a semi-field experiment aiming to analyze the sensitivity of two solitary bee species (*Osmia bicornis* and *O. brevicornis*), since the toxicity of pesticides to solitary species (especially oligolectic species) is largely unexplored. The HiWis will participate at preparations, field work, data collection, and data organization.

Position

Student assistants (40-80 hours per month) with an education background in the environmental sciences, biology or a related field of study. The pay grade is determinant on the student's educational level.

Duration

April 2025 to June/July 2025 (3-4 months). Most of the field work will be probably carried out in the month of May.

Requirements

- Ability to participate in fieldwork at the test site in Freiburg (Messe).
- Motivation, reliability, willingness to learn and communicate in a team.
- Willingness to do fieldwork in the evening/at night to a certain extent
